Act No. 3, 1913.

An Act to apply certain sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund towards the Services of the Year 1913-1914, and out of the Public Works Fund, and out of the General Loan Account for Services to be hereafter provided for by Loan. [Assented to, 1st September, 1913.]

WHEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and Preamble. loyal subjects, the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of eight millions one hundred and twenty-three thousand one hundred and sixty pounds, that is to say—

Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the sum of One million five hundred and thirty-six thousand

two hundred pounds, being the sum required to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the months of September, October, November, and December, or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fourteen; and the sum of Three millions and fifty-nine thousand seven hundred pounds for the Services set forth in Schedule A hereto annexed.

Out of the Public Works Fund, the sum of Eightyfour thousand three hundred pounds for the Services set forth in Schedule B hereto annexed.

Out of the General Loan Account the sum of Three millions four hundred and forty-two thousand nine hundred and sixty pounds for the Services set forth in Schedule C hereto annexed:

And whereas we desire to make good out of the said funds and the General Loan Account the sum so granted to His Majesty: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—
