Act No. 3, 1913.

An Act to apply certain sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund towards the Services of the Year 1913-1914, and out of the Public Works Fund, and out of the General Loan Account for Services to be hereafter provided for by Loan. [Assented to, 1st September, 1913.]

WHEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and Preamb e. loyal subjects, the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of eight millions one hundred and twenty-three thousand one hundred and sixty pounds, that is to say—

Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty, the sum of Four millions five hundred and ninety-five thousand nine hundred pounds, of which the sum of One million five hundred and thirty-six thousand two hundred pounds is to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirteen, to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the months of September, October, November, and December, or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fourteen, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1913-1914, and the

the sum of Three millions and fifty-nine thousand seven hundred pounds is to be expended for the Services specified in Schedule A hereto annexed.

2. Out of the Public Works Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty the sum of Eighty-four thousand three hundred pounds for the Services specified in Schedule B hereto annexed.

3. The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sums for the Services aforesaid in such manner and in such proportions as the Governor, by Warrants or Orders in writing under his hand, and directed to the said Treasurer, shall from time to time order and direct. And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund and the Public Works Fund and the General Loan Account respectively.
