Act No. 2, 1913.

An Act to apply certain sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund towards the Services of the Year 1913-1914, and out of the Public Works Fund, and out of the General Loan Account for Services to be hereafter provided for by Loan. [Assented to, 31st July, 1913.]

**W**HEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and Preamble. loyal subjects, the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of three millions eight hundred and thirty-seven thousand three hundred and fifty pounds, that is to say—

Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the sum of seven hundred and seventeen thousand pounds,

pounds, being the sum required to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the months of July and August, or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fourteen; and the sum of One million six hundred and fifty-seven thousand three hundred pounds for the Services set forth in Schedule A hereto annexed.

Out of the Public Works Fund, the sum of Seventeen thousand pounds for the Services set forth in Schedule B hereto annexed.

Out of the General Loan Account the sum of One million four hundred and forty-six thousand and fifty pounds for the services set forth in Schedule C hereto annexed:

And whereas we desire to make good out of the said funds and the General Loan Account the sum so granted to His Majesty: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**1.** Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty, the sum of Two millions three hundred and seventy-four thousand three hundred pounds, of which the sum of Seven hundred and seventeen thousand pounds is to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirteen, to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the months of July and August, or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fourteen, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1913-1914, and the sum of One million

million six hundred and fifty-seven thousand three hundred pounds is to be expended for the Services specified in Schedule A hereto annexed.

**2.** Out of the Public Works Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty the sum of Seventeen thousand pounds for the Services specified in Schedule B hereto annexed.

£17,000 may be issued out of the Public Works Fund.

**3.** Notwithstanding the provisions of the Audit Act, 1902, there shall and may be issued out of the General Loan Account and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty, the sum of One million four hundred and forty-six thousand and fifty pounds for the Services specified in Schedule C hereto annexed.

£1,446,050 may be issued out of General Loan Account.

**4.** The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sums for the Services aforesaid in such manner and in such proportions as the Governor, by Warrants or Orders in writing under his hand, and directed to the said Treasurer, shall from time to time order and direct. And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the Public Works Fund, and the General Loan Account respectively.

Treasurer to pay under Governor's Warrant or Order.

**5.** The Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for all sums of money paid by him in pursuance of such Warrants or Orders. And the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid shall be full and valid discharges to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for such sums as shall be therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.

Treasurer to have credit and receipts to discharge him.

**6.** This Act may be cited as the "Supply Act, 1913." Short title.

Act No.     , 1913.

An Act to apply certain sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund towards the Services of the Year 1913-1914, and out of the Public Works Fund, and out of the General Loan Account for Services to be hereafter provided for by Loan.

**W**HEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and Preamble. loyal subjects, the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of three millions eight hundred and thirty-seven thousand three hundred and fifty pounds, that is to say—

Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the sum of seven hundred and seventeen thousand

5 pounds, being the sum required to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the months of July and August, or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fourteen; and the sum of One million six hundred and fifty-seven thousand three hundred pounds, for the Services set forth in Schedule A hereto annexed.

10 Out of the Public Works Fund, the sum of Seventeen thousand pounds for the Services set forth in Schedule B hereto annexed.

15 Out of the General Loan Account the sum of One million four hundred and forty-six thousand and fifty pounds for the services set forth in Schedule C hereto annexed:

20 And whereas we desire to make good out of the said funds and the General Loan Account the sum so granted to His Majesty: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

25 **1.** Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of £2,374,300 New South Wales there shall and may be issued and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the supply so out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund. resolved to be granted to His Majesty, the sum of Two millions three hundred and seventy-four thousand 30 three hundred pounds, of which the sum of Seven hundred and seventeen thousand pounds is to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirteen, to defray the 35 expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the months of July and August, or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fourteen, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the 40 expenditure of the year 1913-1914, and the sum of One million

million six hundred and fifty-seven thousand three hundred pounds is to be expended for the Services specified in Schedule A hereto annexed.

2. Out of the Public Works Fund there shall and £17,000 may be issued out of the Public Works Fund.  
5 may be issued and applied for or towards making good the supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty the sum of Seventeen thousand pounds for the Services specified in Schedule B hereto annexed.

3. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Audit Act, £1,446,950 may be issued out of General Loan Account.  
10 1902, there shall and may be issued out of the General Loan Account and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty, the sum of One million four hundred and forty-six thousand and fifty pounds for the Services specified in Schedule C  
15 hereto annexed.

4. The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sums Treasurer to pay under Governor's Warrant or Order.  
for the Services aforesaid in such manner and in such proportions as the Governor, by Warrants or Orders in writing under his hand, and directed to the said Treasurer,  
20 shall from time to time order and direct. And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the Public Works Fund, and the General Loan Account respectively.

5. The Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to Treasurer to have credit and receipts to discharge him.  
25 time be allowed credit for all sums of money paid by him in pursuance of such Warrants or Orders. And the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid shall be full and valid discharges to  
30 the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for such sums as shall be therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.

6. This Act may be cited as the "Supply Act, 1913." Short title.
