The council may, on any land which has been or may hereafter be purchased or resumed by it for the purpose of carrying out improvements in or remodelling any portion of the city, or which may hereafter be purchased or resumed for the purpose of erecting dwelling-houses thereon, erect dwelling-houses, and may let them on such terms and on such conditions as the council thinks fit.

4. The expenses of and in connection with the erection of such buildings may be defrayed out of moneys borrowed for that purpose.
