

GEORGI V REGIS.

Act No. 47, 1912.

An Act to provide for constructing, maintaining, and governing a college for the training of teachers; and for purposes consequent thereon or incidental thereto. [Assented to, 26th November, 1912.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Teachers' College Act, Short title. 1912."

2. The Minister of Public Instruction may, on the land described in the Schedule to this Act, construct buildings as a college for the training of teachers. Construction and management of college.

The possession, control, and management of the said land and buildings shall be exclusively vested in the said Minister for the purposes of the said college, and for no other purpose; and the college shall be governed by him.

ALL that piece or parcel of land containing 1 acre 3 roods 32 perches or thereabouts, Camperdown Ward, city of Sydney, parish of Petersham, county of Cumberland : Commencing at a point bearing north 23 degrees 56 minutes west and distant 5 chains $88\frac{1}{2}$ links from the northernmost corner of the site for Training College, as shown on plan catalogued Ms. 2,879 Sy. in the Department of Lands ; and bounded thence by an arc of a circle of 20 chains radius, the chord of which bears north 46 degrees 50 minutes west 5 chains $55\frac{1}{2}$ links, and is situated on the south-west of said arc ; thence by a line bearing north 19 degrees 9 minutes east $24\frac{1}{4}$ links ; thence by an arc of another circle of 11 chains radius, the chord of which bears north 85 degrees 9 minutes east 2 chains $54\frac{7}{10}$ links, and is situated on the south of the said arc ; thence by lines bearing south 87 degrees 24 minutes east 3 chains $92\frac{1}{10}$ links south 17 degrees 6 minutes east 3 chains $15\frac{1}{10}$ links and south 72 degrees 54 minutes west 3 chains $57\frac{1}{10}$ links to the point of commencement, as shown upon a plan in the Department of Lands catalogued Ms. 3,561 Sy.

ALL that piece or parcel of land containing 1 acre 3 roods 32 perches or thereabouts, Camperdown Ward, city of Sydney, parish of Petersham, county of Cumberland : Commencing at a point bearing north 23 degrees 56 minutes west and distant 5 chains 88 $\frac{1}{2}$ links from the northernmost corner of the site for Training College, as shown on plan catalogued Ms. 2,879 Sy. in the Department of Lands ; and bounded thence by an arc of a circle of 20 chains radius, the chord of which bears north 46 degrees 50 minutes west 5 chains 55 $\frac{1}{2}$ links, and is situated on the south-west of said arc ; thence by a line bearing north 19 degrees 9 minutes east 24 $\frac{1}{10}$ links ; thence by an arc of another circle of 11 chains radius, the chord of which bears north 85 degrees 9 minutes east 2 chains 54 $\frac{7}{10}$ links, and is situated on the south of the said arc ; thence by lines bearing south 87 degrees 24 minutes east 3 chains 92 $\frac{1}{10}$ links south 17 degrees 6 minutes east 3 chains 15 $\frac{8}{10}$ links and south 72 degrees 54 minutes west 3 chains 57 $\frac{6}{10}$ links to the point of commencement, as shown upon a plan in the Department of Lands catalogued Ms. 3,561 Sy.

Being part of an area of 126 acres granted to the University of Sydney on the 18th January, 1855.


