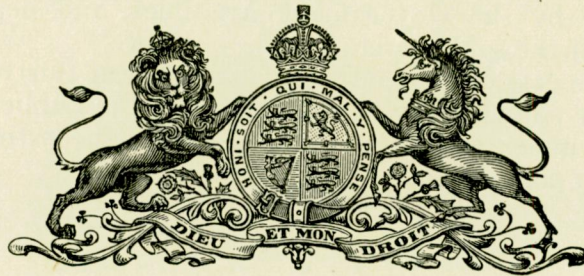

Act No. 30, 1910.

An Act to sanction the completion of the erection of a Library within the grounds of the University of Sydney; and for other purposes. [Assented to, 22nd December, 1910.]

**W**HEREAS in accordance with the provisions of the Public Works Act, 1900, the Legislative Assembly did, by resolution, declare that it was expedient to carry out a certain work, namely, the completion of the erection of a Library within the grounds of the University of Sydney in connection with that University: And whereas, on the passing of the said resolution, a statutory duty was by the said Act imposed on the Secretary for Public Works to introduce a Bill into the said Assembly to sanction the carrying out of the said work: Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the "University of Sydney (Fisher Library Completion) Act, 1910."

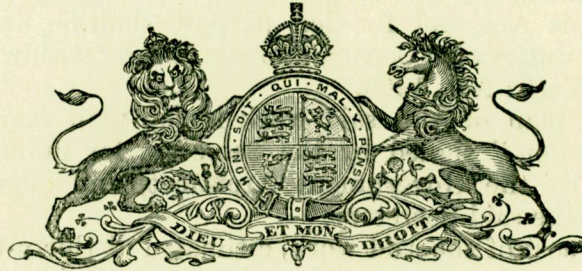

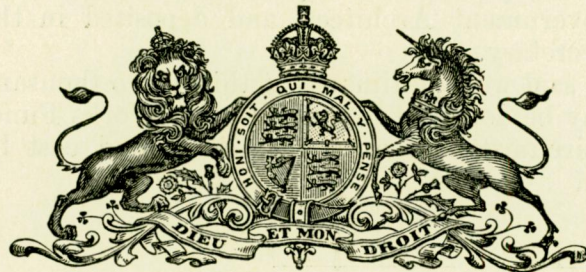
