Act No. , 1916.

An Act to provide that officers in the public service of New South Wales may be nominated and elected to the Legislative Assembly and that when so elected any such officer shall resign his position in the said service; to amend the Constitution Act, 1902; and for other purposes.

DE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty.) by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of 5 the same, as follows :---

1. This Act may be cited as the "Constitution Short title. (Public Service) Amendment Act, 1916." 841-58511

Constitution (Public Service) Amendment.

(1) Nothing in section twenty-six of the Constitu-Public sertion Act, 1902, shall be deemed to have extended or vants nominashall extend to any person otherwise qualified who holds election as any office of profit in the public service of New South members of Parliament.
