

An Act to amend the Dentists (Amendment) Act, 1916. [Assented to, 4th October, 1916.]

B<sup>E</sup> it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Dentists (Further short title. Amendment) Act, 1916." 2.

- (e) In subsection four, after the first paragraph and before the first proviso insert the words :— "Any person who proves to the satisfaction of board that he has practised in dentistry in New South Wales on his own account for not less than eight years prior to the commencement of this Act shall be entitled to be registered as a dentist under this Act".
