Act No. , 1916.

An Act to apply the provisions of Part I of the Electric Lighting and Gas Emergency Act, 1916, to other persons and corporations supplying electricity; and for purposes consequent thereon or incidental thereto.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Electric Supply Further Regulation Act, 1916." Short title.

Electric Supply Further Regulation.

2. Part I of the Electric Lighting and Gas Emergency Act, 1916 (except section two and three thereof) shall, mutatis mutandis, apply to persons and corporations (including the council of a municipality) other than the Municipal Council of Sydney supplying electricity :

Application of Part I of Electric Lighting and Gas Emergency Act, 1916.

For the purpose of so applying such Part of the said Act—

- 10 (a) " board " means a board of five persons which the Governor is hereby authorised to appoint ;
- (b) " electricity " means electricity or electric current generated or supplied by any such person or corporation ;
- 15 (c) references to " the council " shall be construed as references to the person or corporation generating or supplying electricity.
- (d) The following shall take the places of sections seven and eight of the said Part :—

20 7. All notifications by the board shall be published in the Gazette and posted in some conspicuous place at the office of the said person or corporation.

25 8. The operation of the provisions of any Act which are inconsistent with this Act is hereby suspended during such time as this Act is in force.

3. This Act shall remain in force until the Governor by proclamation in the Gazette declares that the necessity for the same has ceased to exist, whereupon this Act shall be deemed to be repealed as and from the date of such proclamation.

Duration of Act.

4. This Act shall bind the Crown.
