A BILL

To enable certain elections to be held and certain things to be done during the second session of the present Parliament; to amend the Public Works Act, 1912, and certain other Acts; and for other purposes.

B^E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of 5 the same, as follows :--

1. This Act may be cited as the "Public Works Short title Committee Election Enabling Act, 1914."

Certain elections may be held and things done during the second resent Parliament.

2. (1) Where by any Act any election is directed to be held, or anything done in the first session of any Parliament, such election may be held and such thing done notwithstanding the provisions of any such Act, in the session of the second session of the present Parliament as if such 5 second session were the first session.

> (2) The provisions of any such Act relating to the holding of such elections, to the powers and duties of any Committees elected thereby, and to the performance of such things, shall, mutatis mutandis, apply to elec- 10 tions held, Committees elected, and things performed under the provisions of this Act.

In such application the words "second session" in any such Act shall, for the purposes of this Act, be substituted for "first session": 15 .

Provided that the date up to and including which nominations of members for election and appointment as members of the Parliamentary Standing Committee on Public Works shall be received, shall be fixed within seven days after the commencement of this Act; and 20 such date shall be not later than fourteen days after such commencement.
