BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Randwick Loan Short title. Act, 1915."

Randwick Loan.

Power of council to borrow for certain purposes.

2. The council of the municipality of Randwick may, subject to the Governor's approval, borrow a sum not exceeding eight thousand pounds, for the following purposes :-

(a) To pay liabilities incurred for the erection surf-bathing accommodation within the

municipality:

(b) to erect additional surf-bathing accommodation;

(c) to repay to the general fund such sum as the Minister approves, being expenditure incurred during the years one thousand nine hundred and thirteen and one thousand nine hundred and fourteen on new surf-bathing accommodation for Coogee and Clovelly beaches; and

(d) to provide fittings, costumes, and appliances for the surf-bathing accommodation in the

municipality.

3. The provisions of the law for the time being in Application force relating to local government shall apply to government law. such borrowing and to this Act, except the provisions relating to—
