Act No. 26, 1915.

An Act to apply certain sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund towards the Services of the Year 1915-1916, and out of the Public Works Fund, and out of the General Loan Account for Services to be hereafter provided for by Loan. [Assented to, 30th September, 1915.]

WHEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and Preamble.
loyal subjects, the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of Three millions two hundred and ninety-seven thousand five hundred and thirty pounds, that is to say—

Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the sum of
Two millions three hundred and thirty-one
thousand

Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty, the sum of Two millions three hundred and thirty-one thousand pounds, to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifteen, to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the months of October and November, or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixteen, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1915-1916.

2. Out of the Public Works Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty the sum of Sixty-one thousand one hundred pounds for the Services specified in Schedule A hereto annexed.

And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund and the Public Works Fund and the General Loan Account respectively.

5. The Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for all sums of money paid by him in pursuance of such Warrants or Orders. 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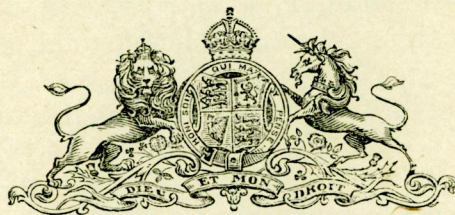
