Act No. 52, 1916.

An Act to apply certain sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund towards the Services of the Year 1916-1917, and out of the Public Works Fund, and out of the General Loan Account for Services to be hereafter provided for by Loan. [Assented to, 4th October, 1916.]

WHEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and Preamble. loyal subjects, the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of Nine millions nine hundred and six thousand four hundred and ninety pounds, that is to say—

Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the sum of One million nine hundred and ninety-four thousand six hundred pounds, being the

be made in the expenditure of the year 1916-1917, and the sum of Four millions one hundred and twenty-three thousand six hundred and seventy pounds is to be expended for the Services specified in Schedule A hereto annexed.

An Act to apply certain sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund towards the Services of the Year 1916-1917, and out of the Public Works Fund, and out of the General Loan Account for Services to be hereafter provided for by Loan.

WHEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and Preamble.
