Act No. 21, 1914.

An Act to apply certain sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund towards the Services of the Year 1914-1915, and out of the Public Works Fund, and out of the General Loan Account for Services to be hereafter provided for by Loan. [Assented to, 30th October, 1914.]

WHEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and Preamble.
loyal subjects, the Members of the Legislative
Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled,
have

have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of One million four hundred and two thousand one hundred and fifty pounds, that is to say—

- Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the sum of One million one hundred and sixty-five thousand nine hundred pounds, being the sum required to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the month of November, or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifteen.
- Out of the Public Works Fund, the sum of Eighteen thousand two hundred and fifty pounds for the Services set forth in Schedule A hereto annexed:
- Out of the General Loan Account the sum of Two hundred and eighteen thousand pounds for the Services set forth in Schedule B hereto annexed:

And whereas we desire to make good out of the said Funds and the General Loan Account the sum so granted to His Majesty: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

£1,165,900 may be issued out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund.

1. Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty, the sum of One million one hundred and sixty-five thousand nine hundred pounds, to be expended at the rates which are shown on the Estimates for the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifteen, as laid upon the Table of the House, to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the month of November, or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifteen, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1914–1915. 2.

- 2. Out of the Public Works Fund there shall and £18,250 may may be issued and applied for or towards making good of the Public the supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty the Works Fund. sum of Eighteen thousand two hundred and fifty pounds for the services specified in Schedule A hereto annexed.
- 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Audit Act, £218,000 1902, there shall and may be issued out of the General may be issued Loan Account and applied for or towards making good Loan the supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty, the sum of Two hundred and eighteen thousand pounds for the Services specified in Schedule B hereto annexed.
- 4. The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sums Treasurer to for the Services aforesaid in such manner and in such pay under Governor's proportions as the Governor, by Warrants or Orders in Warrant or writing under his hand, and directed to the said Order. Treasurer, shall from time to time order and direct. And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund and the Public Works Fund and the General Loan Account respectively.
- 5. The Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to Treasurer to time be allowed credit for all sums of money paid by have credit him in pursuance of such Warrants or Orders. And to discharge the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid shall be full and valid discharges to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for such sums as shall be therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.
- 6. This Act may be cited as the "Supply Act (No. 4), Short title. 1914."
