WHEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and Preamble.

Out of the Public Works Fund, the sum of Seventeen thousand pounds for the Services set forth in Schedule A hereto annexed:

Out of the General Loan Account the sum of Four hundred and twenty-five thousand five hundred pounds for the Services set forth in Schedule B hereto annexed:
