An Act to apply certain sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund towards the Services of the Year 1916-1917, and out of the Public Works Fund, and out of the General Loan Account for Services to be hereafter provided for by Loan. [Assented to, 28th July, 1916.]

WHEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and Preamble. loyal subjects, the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of Three millions nine hundred and forty-two thousand eight hundred and fifty pounds, that is to say—

Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the sum of One million and ninety-one thousand pounds, being the sum required to defray the expenses
