To HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR,—

The Trustees of the Australian Museum have the honor to submit to your Excellency their Fifty-sixth Report, being for the year ended 30th June, 1910.

1. TRUSTEES.

There has been no change in the personnel of the Trustees during the year. Professor W. A. Haswell and Mr. Hugh Pollock were granted leave of absence; the former to visit Europe, the latter owing to illness. A list of the Trustees, with records of their attendance during the year 1909, will be found in Appendix II.

2. STAFF.

No changes among the superior officers have occurred, but among the Messengers, Mechanics, and Attendants a few departures occurred, entailing new engagements. Owing to the need for assistance in the new buildings, four additional attendants were also engaged.

A list of the Staff as at 30th June, 1910, will be found in Appendix VIII.

3. VISITORS.

The Museum continued open throughout the year during the usual hours, viz., on week-days (Mondays excepted) 10 a.m. to 5 p.m., and on Sundays from 2 to 5 p.m. The number of visitors recorded on week-days was 162,066, averaging 606, and on Sundays 52,002, averaging 1,000 per day, making a total of 214,068. On Mondays, except when a public holiday falls on that day, the Museum is closed for cleaning; but in the afternoon students and pupils of public and private schools, with their teachers, are admitted, and are given facilities for study and teaching. These opportunities are being increasingly taken advantage of, 638 persons having visited the Museum on Monday afternoons for study. Teachers frequently bring their classes on ordinary visiting days also for instruction.

Details of the monthly returns for attendance will be found in Appendix III.

4. LECTURES.

The new Lecture Room has been in occupation during the past year, and has proved a most useful adjunct. It is fitted up in modern style with comfortable seats and desks on a raised gallery, for the audience, and table, desk, blackboards, gas and water fittings, for the lecturers. An oxyhydrogen lantern has been provided, and most of the lectures are now illustrated by means of it in addition to the usual specimens from the Museum itself.

Whilst these lectures are primarily intended for teachers, any of the general public who may be interested are cordially welcomed. It is hoped to extend the scope of the lectures as circumstances may indicate.

A Syllabus of the Lectures delivered during the last year, with those in preparation, will be found in Appendix VII.

5. ACQUISITIONS.

The collections in the Museum continue to be maintained in good order, and are constantly being added to by means of donations, purchases, and exchanges with other Museums, though an efficient collecting staff is still an urgent desideratum, funds being insufficient to provide one.

Amongst the most noticeable additions during the past year are :—

Some fine Ethnological Collections from New Guinea.

A series of rare Insects from Northern Queensland.

A remarkable Sarcophagus and remains from New Caledonia.

A collection of Pottery and other articles of the ancient Incas from Peru.

A collection of Fishes from the Philippine Islands.

6. BUILDINGS.

The Lecture Hall and other portions of the New South Wing were opened by His Excellency Lord Chelmsford, Governor of New South Wales, on Monday, 11th April, 1910, in the presence of a distinguished gathering. His Excellency and Lady Chelmsford were received by The Honorable J. A. Hogue, Minister of Public Instruction, Mr. P. Board, Under Secretary, and the Trustees, in the Board Room, and after a brief interval adjourned to the Lecture Hall where the visitors were assembled. The President, Dr. James C. Cox, reviewed the history of the Museum up to the present time, and introduced the Governor.

Lord Chelmsford gave a most interesting address, and formally declared the new building open to the public. He was briefly followed by the Minister of Public Instruction, by Professor T. W. E. David, one of the Trustees, and by Mr. Chas. Hedley, Assistant Curator, the latter two of whom spoke of the aims and objects of the Museum, more especially emphasising its educational value. The visitors then dispersed to inspect the building and specimens displayed in it.

On the First Floor the Australian and New Zealand Ethnological Specimens have been arranged in the largest room; the American, European, Egyptian, and Miscellaneous Specimens and the "Cook" Relics are in a bay off this room. The New Guinea Specimens are in process of arrangement in the next room.

On the Ground Floor the Osteological Collection has been withdrawn from the crowded cases in the Main Hall, and displayed in the larger of the two new rooms, thus providing space for a better exhibition of the mounted Mammals in the old buildings.

The new Group of Lions has been placed near the entrance of the Main Building, and forms both a conspicuous, most interesting and attractive exhibit.

In Appendix IX will be found photographs of the New Galleries.

7. LIBRARY.

The additions to the Library during the year 1909 amounted to 998 volumes, irrespective of unbound pamphlets.

The number of Catalogue slips and cards prepared during the year was 2,765, but no progress was made in printing the Catalogue owing to pressure of other work in the printer's room.

A list of the additions to the Library will be found in Appendix VI.

8. PUBLICATIONS.

The Museum publications issued since last Report and now in preparation are :—

"Records of the Australian Museum," Vol. VII, Parts 4 and 5, the latter containing the Index and completing the volume, have been published

"Australian Museum Memoirs," Vol. IV ("Thetis" Expedition), part 2, Echinodermata, by Mr. H. Lyman Clark, and part 12, Amphipoda, by Rev. Thos. R. R. Stebbing, have been published. Part 13, Aleyonarians, by Prof. J. A. Thomson and Miss D. L. Mackinnon, is in the press.

Special Catalogue No. 1, "Nests and Eggs of Birds," by Mr. A. J. North, Vol. II, Parts 3 and 4, the latter being the index number, have been published. Vol. III is well under way in manuscript, and will shortly be sent to press.

A list of Museum publications is given in Appendix V.

9. FISHERY INVESTIGATIONS.

The arrangements made with the Commonwealth Fishery Department have been continued, and Members of the Museum Staff have had opportunities of accompanying the Commonwealth Fishery Investigation Vessel "Endeavour" at various times to mutual advantage. The bulk of the specimens collected for scientific purposes is at once forwarded to this Museum after each trip, where it is sorted and examined. A portion is put aside for the future Fishery Museum to be established by the Commonwealth Government in connection with the Department, a second portion is retained for this Museum, and the remainder is distributed among the various Australian Museums. Already there have been eight consignments from the "Endeavour," approximating 3,081 specimens.

These have been distributed as follows:—Commonwealth Fisheries Department, 1,347 specimens; Australian Museum, 1,500; National Museum, 55; South Australian Museum, 52; Western Australian Museum, 43; Queensland Museum, 40; Tasmanian Museum, 44. There still remains a large number of specimens to be distributed.

Much valuable information has been gained, and many new specimens secured. Particulars of these are being worked out, and will be published in due time.

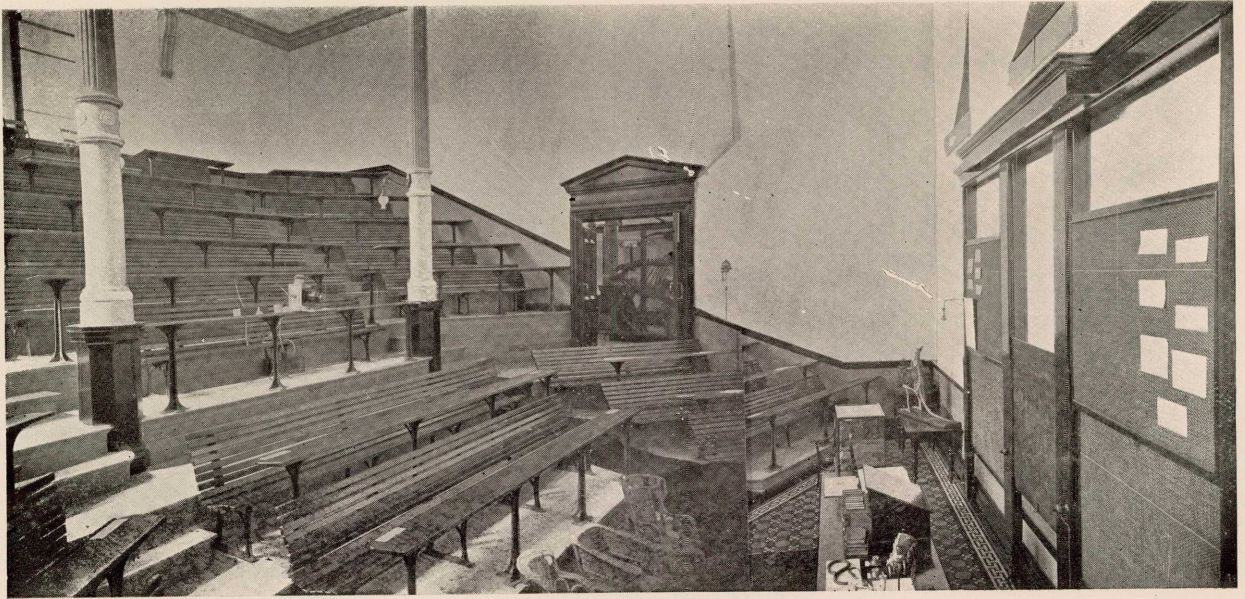

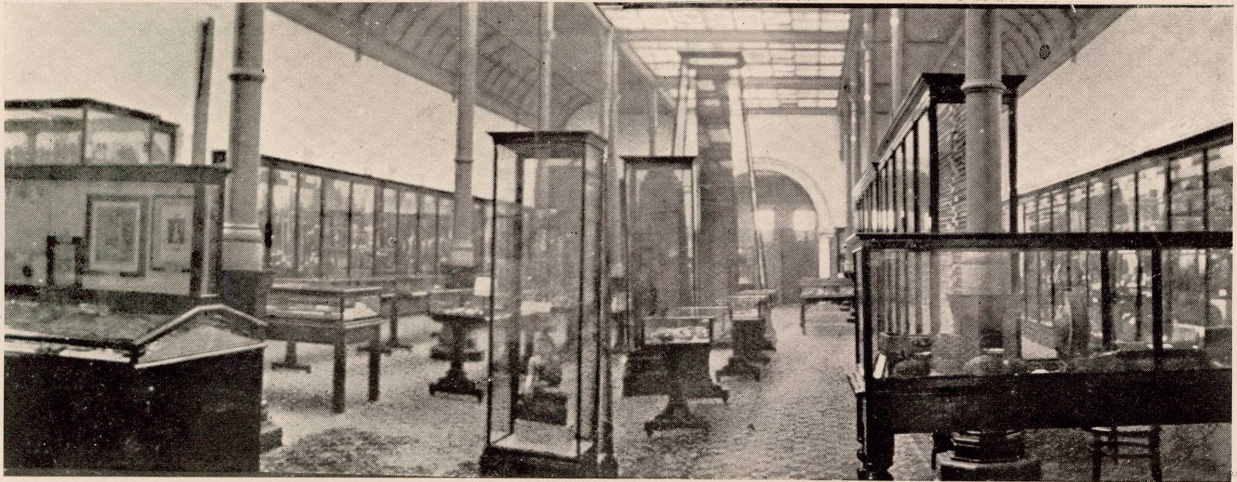

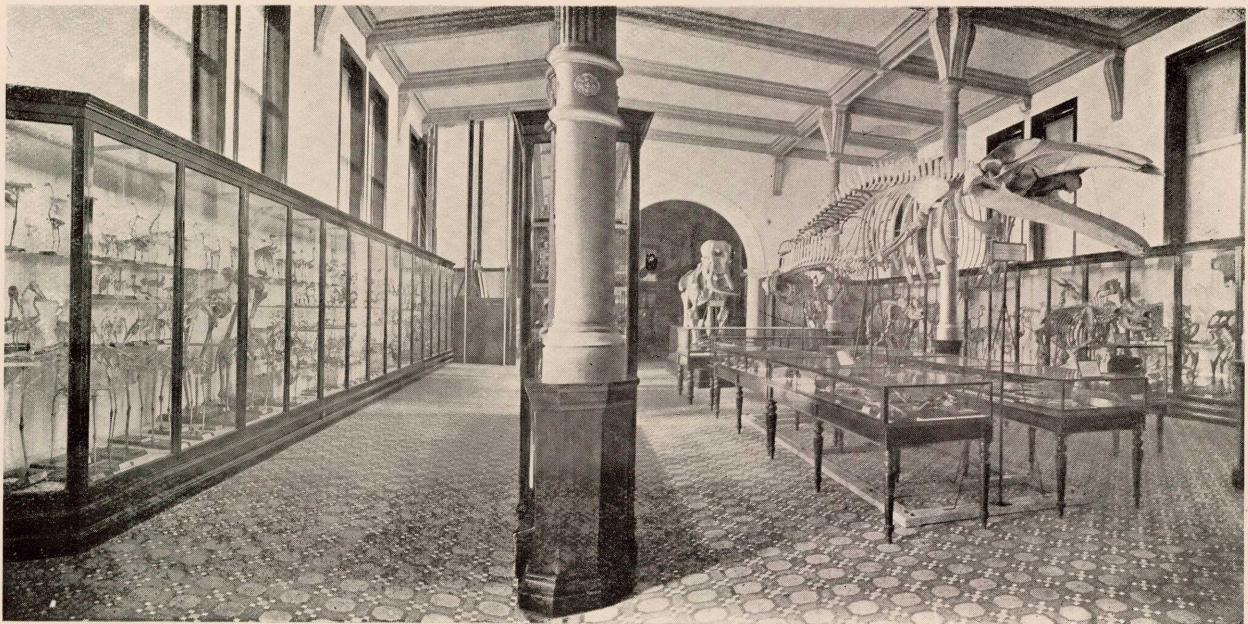
