What avenues are open to constituents to have Council matters resolved when Council cuts services as proposed by Newcastle City Council including: rangers who look after barking dog complaints, noise complaints, too many animals complaints?

Answer—

I provide the following details in response to your questions:

Under the Local Government Act 1993, councils have a high degree of autonomy, responsibility and accountability – as well as the flexibility to devise strategies for efficiently delivering services and performing their regulatory activities. They are accountable to their electors for their actions. Neither I as the Minister for Local Government, nor the Division of Local Government, has the power to intervene in the day-to-day operations of individual councils, including their handling of complaints.

If residents and ratepayers have any concerns about the Council's services, they should write to the Council's General Manager or contact their local councillors. They are responsible for reviewing the Council's performance and helping to resolve any community concerns.
