I am advised:

Staffing numbers are formally recorded at the Police Area Command or Police District level. Staffing at any particular police station can fluctuate daily in response to crime trends and other intelligence led operational requirements.

All police positions attached to a Police Area Command or Police District are flexible resources available to respond to incidents across the local area. Local resources are also supplemented by specialist police (highway patrol, major crime squads, covert resources, and others) who are managed centrally and can be deployed across Police Area Command and Police District boundaries in response to operational needs.

Answer—

I am advised:

On NSW roads, collisions with kangaroos and wallabies result in about 100 serious injuries to road users a year. The Dubbo Automated Vehicle trial is an example of the NSW Government's commitment to improving road safety and network efficiency through the development and adoption of Automated Vehicle technology. Transport for NSW has partnered with industry leaders, researchers, local councils and businesses to develop and co-deliver this trial.

It is important that technology isn 't reserved for metropolitan roads and road users. Kangaroo detection was one of the elements identified as unique to the regional NSW context that required consideration in these trials to develop safer vehicles and greater mobility within NSW.

Real world learnings through trials like in Dubbo will assist NSW to better understand emerging technologies as well as support investment in the development of local technology skills and industry capability.
