Answer—

- (1) I am advised by the NSW Electoral Commission that the Commission is in the process of reviewing and reporting on whether internet and other forms of technology assisted voting can be provided at future NSW elections and referenda for particular classes of eligible voters, and if so, in what form and at what scale.

The review will report on the administrative and legislative steps to implement any recommended options for technology assisted voting, as well the potential financial and other resourcing impacts for the NSW Electoral Commission and NSW Government.

The NSW Electoral Commission has advised that it has received submissions from a variety of individuals, groups, organisations and government bodies in response to the review. An interim review paper is due to be published in June 2023 and the final review paper is due to be presented to the Government in August 2023.

- (2) Section 271 of the Electoral Act 2017 provides that the Electoral Commissioner is to conduct a review of the administration of each general election and to provide a report on the outcome of the review.

I am advised by the Electoral Commissioner that it is anticipated that a report on the 2023 State general election will be provided by 25 September 2023, and that the report will consider trends in relation to voting by electors who are overseas or travelling during the election period.

The report will be tabled in each House of Parliament within a month of receipt.

The Government will carefully consider any recommendations made by the Commission that recommend action be taken by the Government.

- (3) The NSW Electoral Commission has advised that it will publish a final review paper in relation to its review of technology assisted voting by August 2023. It would not be appropriate for the Government to pre-empt the findings and recommendations of the review.
