\* 0280 INCIDENT INVOLVING USE OF A TASER INVOLVING A 95 YEAR OLD AT YALLAMBEE LODGE AGED CARE HOME—Mr Gareth Ward to ask the Minister for Police and Counter-terrorism—

- (1) Has the Minister been briefed on this incident?
  - (a) If so, have you given any direction to your Department in relation to this incident?
    - (i) If yes, what is that direction?
- (2) When did Minister advise the Premier of this incident?
- (3) Has the Minister seen the body camera footage?
- (4) Will the body camera footage of this incident be made available to the public?
- (5) Has the Minister met with the Nowland family regarding this incident?
- (6) What training is currently offered to frontline police to support their interaction with people with cognitive disability and cognitive decline?
  - (a) Are there plans to upgrade the current training offered?
- (7) Has the Minister met with the Age and Disability Commissioner regarding this incident?
  - (a) If not, will you meet with the Age and Disability Commissioner?
- (8) Has the Minister met with the Chair of the Ministerial Council for the Aging regarding this incident?
  - (a) If not, will you meet with the Chair of the Ministerial Council for the Aging?

- (6) Commencing at recruitment and continuing throughout their career, NSW Police Force officers undertake various training programs and mandatory continuing policing education.   - (a) The NSW Police Force reviews training regularly to ensure best practice. This may include consideration of research, the occurrence of a critical incident, the findings of a Coronial Inquest, or findings by other oversight bodies.

0286 NUWARRA ROAD MOOREBANK—Mrs Tina Ayyad to ask the Minister for Regional Transport and Roads—

- (1) Does the Government have any plans to upgrade Nuwarra Road, Moorebank?

Answer—

Responsibility for metropolitan roads lies with the Minister for Roads.

Nuwarra Road is under the care and control of Liverpool City Council.

\* 0287 WESTINVEST PROGRAM—Mrs Tina Ayyad to ask the Minister for Planning and Public Spaces representing the Treasurer—

- (1) Does the Government have any plans on adjusting funding commitments made through the WestInvest Program by the previous Government?
- (2) If yes, what programs and projects will have their funding arrangements altered?

Answer—

The NSW Government is committed to progressing the projects approved for funding through the \$2 billion WestInvest Community Project grants stream.

\* 0288 REHABILITATION AND RELEASE PLANNING AND SUPPORT PROGRAMS—Mr Roy Butler to ask the Minister for Police and Counter-terrorism—

- (1) Can the Minister advise the effectiveness of reintegration, rehabilitation and release programs that are offered to prisoners while serving time in jail?
- (2) Can the Minister advise about the effectiveness of support available to former inmates facing numerous physiological challenges when released from prison?

\* 0289 COWRA HOSPITAL REDEVELOPMENT—Ms Steph Cooke to ask the Minister for Health, Minister for Regional Health, and Minister for the Illawarra and the South Coast—

With respect to the \$110.2 million redevelopment of Cowra Hospital:

- (1) What is the status of early works at the site?
- (2) When will build of the main infrastructure commence on site?
- (3) How many community information sessions on the project are planned for the next six months?
- (4) When will the Cowra community be provided with an update on the project?

Answer—

- (1) Enabling works are almost complete, with all work expected to be finished in mid-2023.
- (2) The main works contractor is expected to be appointed in mid-2023 through a competitive tender process. Construction will commence shortly thereafter.
- (3) Extensive staff, community and stakeholder consultation has occurred throughout the project to inform the planning and design.

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- (4) In May 2023, the project team issued a newsletter, the Cowra Guardian published a project update, and the project website is regularly updated.

\* 0290 ACCOMODATION FOR NURSING STAFF AT NARRANDERA HEALTH SERVICE—Ms Steph Cooke to ask the Minister for Health, Minister for Regional Health, and Minister for the Illawarra and the South Coast—

With respect to accommodation for nursing staff at Narrandera Health Service:

- (1) How many staff currently reside in this facility?
- (2) What safety and maintenance issues are associated with the facility?
- (3) What plan to rectify these issues has been put in place by the District?

Answer—

- (1 - 3) I am advised that the average number of students and agency nurses housed in the staff accommodation facility is 6. Additionally, three modern houses are leased with average occupancy of 5.

A section of the accommodation facility requires remodelling and is not being used to accommodate staff until upgrades have been completed.

The District has endorsed Narrandera as a site for 3 self-contained units as part of the Key Worker Accommodation project, for expected completion in 2024.

The New Intercity Fleet will be introduced progressively starting with the Central Coast and Newcastle Line. Testing of the new trains is underway. Transport for NSW will continue to work with the Office of the National Rail Safety Regulator and the Rail, Tram, and Bus Union to implement an operating model that will allow trains to enter passenger service in 2024.

\* 0303 FUNDING FOR BOARDRIDERS CLUBS ON THE CENTRAL COAST—Mr Adam Crouch to ask the Premier—

- (1) Will \$10,000 for equipment upgrades be made available to the Macmasters, Avoca, North Avoca and Wamberal Boardriders Clubs?

- (2) Will clubs be provided with information about what equipment will be provided?

Answer—

The NSW Labor Government will deliver all election commitments as promised.

In relation to local water utilities,

- (1) Is the Government planning to afford the same constitutional public ownership protection to customers of local water utilities outside of Sydney and the Hunter?
  - (a) If not, why not?
- (2) Does the Government have any plans to strip local councils of water utility operations?

Answer—

The NSW Government has implemented its commitment to secure Sydney and Hunter Water as public entities. This was achieved through the Constitutional Amendment (Sydney Water and Hunter Water) Bill 2023.

The NSW Government will establish a joint select Inquiry into the issue of how to protect local water utilities.

The NSW Parliamentary Inquiry will determine how we can protect regional water assets and secure the future of water services. The Inquiry will provide the NSW Government with recommendations regarding local water utilities and they will be considered.

The NSW Government recognises the ability of local governments to make decisions about assets that they own and that deliver services to their communities. We will always consult with local government and other stakeholders to ensure their voices are heard.

Under the timeline set in place by the former Liberal and Nationals government, the Before and After School Care (BASC) Voucher Program will end on 30 June 2023.

A total of 184 vouchers have been redeemed in the Northern Tablelands as at 25 May, out of 969 total.

- (1) The Department of Communities and Justice's (DCJ) Social Housing Residential Dwelling Dashboard provides of social housing residential dwellings under tenancy management at a district level. Further, there are also 35 social housing properties in the electorate for dedicated use of indigenous tenancies.

\* 0321 BARTON HIGHWAY DUPLICATION—Mrs Wendy Tuckerman to ask the Minister for Regional Transport and Roads—

- (1) Is the Government planning to complete the Barton Highway duplication in partnership with the Federal Government?
- (2) What is the timeline for completion?

Answer—

I am advised

Transport for NSW is expecting to open the new lanes to traffic for stage one by the end of 2023, although some minor work will be carried out in early 2024.

The Australian Government has committed a further \$100 million for the second stage of the duplication. A construction timeline for stage two is yet to be determined.

\* 0322 NSW REGIONAL ROAD SAFETY PROGRAM—Mrs Wendy Tuckerman to ask the Minister for Regional Transport and Roads—

Is the Government planning to fund the continuation of the New South Wales Regional Road Safety Program without Federal Government contribution?

Answer—

Continuation of funding for the Road Safety Program was announced in the May 2023 Federal Budget, with \$976.7 million available across 2023-24 and 2024-25. Transport for NSW is in discussions with officers from the Federal Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development, Communications and the Arts in relation to next steps for program delivery.

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\* 0323 FUNDING FOR COMMUNITY INFRASTRUCTURE—Mrs Wendy Tuckerman to ask the Minister for Police and Counter-terrorism representing the Minister for Agriculture, Minister for Regional New South Wales, and Minister for Western New South Wales—

- (1) Has the Government advocated for the Federal Labor Government to maintain the incredibly successful Local Roads and Community Infrastructure Program?
- (2) How will the Government support local councils to plan community infrastructure in advance?
  - (a) Does this support change depending on how much funding they receive outside of the grant application process?

\* 0324 SCHOOL BUS SERVICES IN THE KIAMA ELECTORATE—Mr Gareth Ward to ask the Minister for Regional Transport and Roads—

With respect to school bus services in the Kiama Electorate:

- (1) How many school bus routes use buses that don't have seat belts?
- (2) How many children are traveling to school from the Kiama Electorate who travel on buses without seat belts?
- (3) When will all school buses in the Kiama Electorate have seat belts?

Answer—

I am advised

(1 - 2) The former Liberal National Government did not establish processes to capture data in the format requested.

- (3) The independently chaired Rural and Regional Seatbelt Program Taskforce established under the former Liberal National Government determined that seatbelts are required only on dedicated school buses in Rural and Regional NSW. There are 46 buses operated under Rural and Regional Bus Service Contracts in the Kiama electorate, comprising of:

- 36 buses with seatbelts fitted;
- 10 low floor, regular route buses which are not included in the Rural and Regional School Bus Seatbelts Program.

The NSW Rural and Regional School Bus Seatbelts Program was extended to selected outer metropolitan areas where some outer metropolitan school buses travel along some of the same high-risk roads as the Rural and Regional school buses.

Transport for NSW has determined the school bus routes to receive seatbelts based on careful analysis of roads with higher risk ratings, with seatbelts to be installed on buses which regularly travel on roads outside urban areas over longer distances with a speed limit of 80 kilometres an hour and above. No additional school routes in Kiama were identified as meeting the criteria for requiring seatbelts.

\* 0326 TRAFFIC CONGESTION ON THE M1 SOUTH OF WOLLONGONG—Mr Gareth Ward to ask the Minister for Transport representing the Minister for Jobs and Tourism, Special Minister of State, Minister for Roads, Minister for the Arts, and Minister for Music and the Night-time Economy—

With respect to traffic congestion on the M1 south of Wollongong:

Answer—

I am advised

- (1) Transport for NSW is investigating solutions to improve transport in the Illawarra region, including along the Princes Motorway. These investigations will build on previous work and consider the transport outcomes outlined in the Future Transport Strategy as well as the Illawarra Shoalhaven Regional Transport Plan. The focus is also on encouraging mode shift towards more sustainable modes of transport.
- (2) Several initiatives are being investigated to reduce congestion on the Princes Motorway including:
  - New infrastructure on the Princes Motorway, such as additional lanes and ramps.
  - New road connections to support the NSW Government's West Lake Illawarra Growth Area. These connections aim to reduce the need for new residents to use the Princes Motorway for trips within the Illawarra.
  - Public transport service improvements, including modifications to existing services as well as new services, to connect more residents across the Illawarra Shoalhaven region to the public transport system.
  - Improvements to walking and cycling infrastructure across the region so Illawarra residents feel safer while walking or riding to nearby schools, shops, services, and amenities and choose to instead leave their private vehicle at home.
- (3) The NSW Government has provided \$10 million for planning of additional entry and exit ramps on the M1 Princes Motorway at Dapto.

The Princes Highway Corridor Strategy was released in 2016 and provides a 20-year vision for the corridor. Transport for NSW released the Illawarra-Shoalhaven Regional Transport Plan in 2021 which outlines in the 20-year vision for the transport network across the region and includes initiatives to improve the Princes Motorway.

Additionally, the Draft South East and Tablelands Regional Transport Plan was placed on public exhibition between December 2022 and February 2023 and outlines the 20-year vision for the transport network for the region, including the Princes Highway in the Eurobodalla and Bega Valley local government areas.

- (4) The Princes Highway upgrade program is a multi-decade program of upgrades for the corridor and is summarised in the program's Roadmap to 2040 document. This program will create better connected regional centres with safer, quicker and more reliable journeys for locals, visitors, and freight through a safe, reliable, efficient and connected network.
