2. ELECTION OF MEMBERS TO THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (*Second Election—Fifteen Members*)—TAKING OF THE VOTES OF THE MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL:—The President directed the Clerk to read the Order of the Day. The Order of the Day having been read, the Clerk duly displayed the ballot-box. And it being Ten o'clock, a.m., the hour appointed in the writ dated 10th October, 1933, for the commencement of the taking of the votes of Members, the President declared the ballot open, and the taking of the votes of Members thereupon commenced.

And it being Six o'clock, p.m., the hour appointed in the writ for the termination of the taking of the votes at the sitting, the President directed that the doors be locked. The doors having been locked, the President inquired whether there was any Member present who had not yet received a ballot-paper and desired to vote. And there being no such Member desiring to vote, the President directed that the doors be unlocked.

And Members who had received their ballot-papers before the hour appointed in the writ for the termination of the taking of the votes having completed before that hour the recording of their votes, the President declared the ballot closed.

3. SPECIAL ADJOURNMENT:—Mr. Manning moved, That this House, at its rising To-day, do adjourn until Tuesday, the 28th November, at 4 o'clock p.m. Question put and passed.

The House adjourned accordingly, at Two minutes after Six o'clock, p.m., until Tuesday, 28th November, 1933, at Four o'clock, p.m.
