Remove paragraphs 5 and 6 and substitute with:

“5. The Committee notes that the proposed Act is to commence on a day or days to be appointed by proclamation. This may delegate to the government the power to commence the Act on whatever day it chooses or not at all. However, the Committee accepts the advice received from the Motor Accidents Authority that commencing the proposed Act by proclamation reflects the differing commencement dates of the various initiatives to be implemented by the proposed Act. The Motor Accident Authority explained that under the bill each provision creates an obligation either on the Motor Accidents Authority or licensed private insurers which can only be commenced when either the necessary revised levy or premium collection arrangements to meet the relevant obligation can be implemented operationally.

6. The Committee has not identified any issues under s8A(1)(b) of the Legislation Review Act 1987.”
