



TERMS OF REFERENCE

The Joint Standing Committee on the Ombudsman, the Police Integrity Commission and the Crime Commission is to inquire into and report on the ways in which performance is measured and reported on in those agencies that the Committee has responsibility for monitoring and reviewing under the relevant legislation.

This inquiry will pay particular regard to:

- a) The reporting requirements of each agency
- b) What measures are currently being used by agencies to assess their performance and effectiveness
- c) How these measures are determined
- d) How effective these measures are considered to be
- e) Any significant overlap or difference in approach between agencies, and
- f) Any other relevant matter.
