

## NSW Government Response to the '2018 Review of the Annual Reports of Oversighted Bodies'

In its report titled '2018 Review of the Annual Reports of Oversighted Bodies' the Committee on the Ombudsman, the Law Enforcement Conduct Commission and the Crime Commission made four recommendations. The recommendations and the NSW Government's responses are articulated in the table below.
