Addendum – Review of ePetitions process

- 1.1 The Committee will review the operation of ePetitions following the adoption of the sessional orders by the House and consider whether changes are needed in relation to:
- (a) The threshold number of electronic signatures required to trigger a debate in the House (20,000 for ePetitions; 10,000 for paper petitions).
 - (b) The adequacy of requirements to identify signatories as residents of New South Wales and issues relating to privacy.
 - (c) The resource implications for the Department of the Legislative Assembly of administering the ePetitions process.
 - (d) Any other relevant matters.
- 1.2 The Committee will complete a review of the operation of ePetitions within twelve months of the sessional orders being adopted by the House.
