## TABLING OF REGULATIONS

In its 4th Report of December 1988 the Committee drew attention to section 40 (1) of the Interpretation Act 1987 which requires written notice of all statutory rules published in the Government Gazette to be laid upon the table of each House of Parliament within 14 sitting days of the House after the day on which they are so published.

The Regulation Review Committee noted that the Legislative Assembly's list of Statutory Instruments Laid Upon the Table showed that a large number of regulations were not tabled or tabled within the specified time.

The Committee said that although failure to table notice of a statutory rule does not affect the validity of the rule, it substantially deprives Parliament of the formal notice intended to be given to it for the purpose of the review of that particular statutory rule and accordingly drew the attention of each Minister to this state of affairs.

The Attorney General and the Parliamentary Counsel subsequently examined a number of ways of resolving the issue but none were implemented. The Committee reminded the Attorney General of this outstanding matter on 19th November 1991. He responded on 19 December 1991 advising that the matter had been referred to the Presiding Officers of the Parliament. He said that the Clerk of the Legislative Assembly had replied on behalf of the Speaker indicating that the preferred position of the Legislative Assembly would be that the Government Gazette be regularly tabled in its entirety, together with a schedule of disallowable statutory instruments.

Under this proposal the Clerk of the House would be authorised to receive the Gazette, through the Office of the Parliamentary Counsel, the Gazette being deemed to be tabled, both during sitting and recess periods. At the next sitting of the House, the Clerk would announce receipt and an entry would be made in the Votes and Proceedings specifying the statutory instruments. The 15 day disallowance period would commence from the next sitting day.

The Attorney General said that in view of the different preferences for reform, his Department would convene a meeting between the Clerks of both Houses, the Parliamentary Counsel and a representative of the Committee to settle an agreed position.

The Committee heard nothing further with regard to this meeting until April 1992 when it had drawn to its attention a letter from the former Minister for the Environment and Leader of the House dated 19th March 1992 which recommended certain reforms for the tabling of statutory instruments. The Committee noted that whilst the proposals outlined in the former Minister's letter of 19th March were similar to those proposed to be discussed there was no mention made of the Committee's involvement and the fact that the Committee had been pursuing similar reforms for the tabling of statutory rules since its 4th Report of December 1988.

The Committee noted that the former Minister proposed that extracts from the Gazette containing regulations should be tabled in the House immediately after publication. This would also mean that the 15 sitting day period within which the Committee can consider regulations would commence immediately after publication. In its 15th Report to Parliament the Committee referred to this proposal and said that it

would be important for the Committee to be properly briefed on the effect and the impact of each statutory instrument immediately upon tabling. At present the Committee does not receive a copy of the Executive Council Minute and other material submitted to the Governor under Section 7 of the Subordinate Legislation Act. If the statutory rule is a principal statutory rule Departments have 28 days in which to send a copy of the regulatory impact statement for that rule and any public comments made on it. Departments frequently exceed this maximum time.

The Committee concluded by stating its view that if the Minister's proposal goes ahead, sections 7 and 5 of the Subordinate Legislation Act should be amended to require the submission to the Committee of the relevant material on the day that the statutory instrument is published in the Gazette.

The Committee wrote to the Premier and Treasurer on 10th July 1992 formally requesting these amendments.

The Premier's Office responded on 1st September 1992 stating that the suggested amendments were still under consideration, but that the Committee could be assured that its views on changes to the Subordinate Legislation Act will be kept in mind in the event of changes being made to the tabling arrangements for statutory instruments.

On 28th October the Committee made further recommendations for reform of the tabling system following on from the submission of the Clerk of the Legislative Assembly on the proposal. It noted that at this stage it is proposed that an alphabetical schedule of statutory rules should be developed indicating by symbol whether the instrument is disallowable under the Interpretation Act or otherwise.

In addition to these symbols the Committee said that it would be appropriate to identify whether a particular statutory rule is a principal statutory rule and whether it has been made as a consequence of the repeal of an earlier statutory rule of the same kind under the Subordinate Legislation Act 1989.

The Committee also noted the request of the Clerks of both Houses for a copy of the disk of each Schedule to be made available to each House. The Committee requested a copy of that disk as well as the hard copy of the list to be provided to it.

Finally the Committee recommended consideration of a further amendment to the Subordinate Legislation Act to require the material referred to the Regulation Review Committee under section 5 to be also submitted to the Parliament at the same time. While it should not be necessary for this material to be formally tabled, it should be available for members inspection, at least during the period in which the regulation may be disallowed. This might be achieved by depositing the material in the Parliamentary Library or making some other arrangement so that members will have ready access to it.

The reason for this recommendation is that members of Parliament retain the right to recommend disallowance of regulations independently of any action the Regulation Review Committee might take.

The Committee is concerned at the time taken to implement the reforms to the tabling system.

The Committee uses the attached list for consideration of regulations during its meeting. This is adapted from the Statutory Instruments publication of the Legislative Assembly.

It will be seen from this list that a number of regulations date back several years and still remain to be tabled in the House. While this extends the time indefinitely during which Parliament may consider the regulations, the object of tabling is for the Parliament to be formally placed on notice of the publication of regulations. While the Interpretation Act 1987 enables Parliament to disallow a regulation from the time it is published in the Gazette and not, as previously, from the date of tabling, the Committee is of the view that if tabling is to have any function, it must serve to put members on notice of the formal introduction of this new legislation.

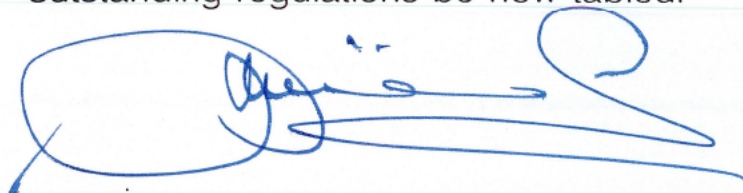
The Committee is aware that in other legislatures the tabling requirements are far more strict. In the Commonwealth Parliament failure to table an instrument within fifteen sitting days under the Acts Interpretation Act means that the instrument ceases to have effect. The Administrative Review Council in its 35th report has recommended that this requirement should be strengthened in that this sanction should also be applied to all instruments of a legislative character under a new Legislative Instruments Act and that the time for tabling be reduced to six sitting days.

The Committee does not generally agree with provisions which automatically render any statutory rule void for failure to comply with these procedural requirements. The regulation in issue may be one of major public safety and could effectively be set aside for the want of formal tabling.

The Committee feels that it is more important to get the procedures in place first for prompt tabling of regulations, and then it may further consider the consequences of failure to table.



The Committee recommends that this matter be urgently examined by the Attorney General with a view to putting in place adequate and enforceable procedures relating to the expeditious tabling of regulations. The Committee also recommends that all outstanding regulations be now tabled.

- \* *filing documents for entry of default judgments against one or more defendants at the same time*
- \* *filing orders for judgements.*

**EXPLANATORY NOTE:** Currently, Ordinance No. 30 under the Local Government Act 1919 deals with the setting up and use of a basket, box, stall, stand or standing vehicle for the purpose of selling goods or the pursuit of a business, calling or employment.

The object of this Ordinance is to amend Ordinance No. 30 by:

- providing that such facilities, including all vehicles other than street vending vehicles, may only be set up and used in accordance with an approval granted by the relevant local council; and
- requiring that before granting an approval, a council must consider the need to avoid the obstruction of traffic and must have regard to street vending guidelines which will be issued by the Department of Local Government and Co-operatives and the Roads and Traffic Authority.

Clause 12 does not apply to the sale of a motor vehicle. Such sales are regulated by clause 12B.

The use of street vending vehicles is regulated by clause 12A of Ordinance 30. This Ordinance amends the definition of "street vending vehicles" to update a reference to a repealed regulation.

<b><i>EXPLANATORY NOTE:</i></b> The object of this Regulation is to amend the State Roads (Toll Works) Regulation 1988 so as to make provision within that Regulation for certain matters relating to the payment of tolls and charges levied in connection with traffic crossing the Sydney Harbour Bridge and for the prohibition of particular commercial activities on the Bridge. The State Roads (Sydney Harbour Bridge) Regulation 1988 is consequently repealed. (At present, the matters concerned are dealt with under the latter Regulation, which applies the relevant provisions of the State Roads (Toll Works) Regulation 1988 to the Bridge.) The Regulation also updates the definition of "authorised officer" and replaces references to the Commissioner for Main roads with references to the Roads and Traffic Authority.					
<i>The Regulation also specifies the amount (\$10) of the charge that is to be paid by the owners of certain vehicles using a toll work (and makes the person who is liable for the charge guilty of an offence if it is not paid.) The vehicles concerned are those whose drivers are allowed to defer payment of a toll (because they reached the toll barrier without sufficient cash to pay the toll) more than once in any 6 months.</i>					
<i>The power to make the Regulation is derived from several different sections of the State Roads Act 1986. Tolls and charges in relation to toll works in general (such as the toll work between Waterfall and Bulli Pass) are covered by section 49, which provides that the Roads and Traffic Authority "may levy, and collect as prescribed, the prescribed tolls and charges in connection with traffic using a toll work". The power to levy tolls and charges in respect of the Sydney Harbour Bridge (which is not a toll work as defined in the Act) is to be found in section 35 (2), which permits the Authority (with the approval of the Governor) to "levy tolls and charges in connection with traffic across a bridge or ferry or through a tunnel". However, the latter power does not extend to the fixing of the amount of the tolls or charges relating to the Sydney Harbour Bridge: those amounts can be fixed only "by order published in the Gazette: (section 35 (5) of the Act). Accordingly, neither the amount of the toll for using the Bridge nor the proposed extension of the \$10 charge to owners in the case of the Bridge appears in the Regulation.</i>
