### Review of the Independent Complaints Officer System (2023)

#### Terms of Reference

- (1) That, in accordance with clause 9 of the resolution establishing the Independent Complaints Officer, agreed to by the Legislative Assembly on 29 March 2022, the Standing Committee on Parliamentary Privileges and Ethics review the Independent Complaints Officer system within 12 months of the establishment of the Independent Complaints Officer position, in consultation with key stakeholders. The committee must examine how the system is operating in practice and whether any changes are needed and in particular:
- the confidentiality provisions applying in respect of complaints and investigations under the system,
  - the timeliness of complaints assessments and investigations conducted under the system, and
  - the provisions applying with respect to standing for complainants and retrospectivity under the system.
