Measures to combat right-wing extremism in New South Wales

Terms of reference

That the Committee on Law and Safety inquire into and report on:

1. The Crimes and Summary Offences Amendment Bill 2025, in particular on constitutional aspects of the bill.
2. Measures to combat right-wing extremism in New South Wales, with particular reference to:
 1. The threat that right-wing extremist movements and organisations in New South Wales pose to the community and impact that they have on particular members in the community, including those they seek to recruit;
 2. Australian and international examples of best practice to combat right-wing extremism;
 3. Methods and practices the Government might adopt to combat right-wing extremism, including:
 1. Community building programs
 2. Deradicalisation programs
 3. Any other mechanisms the Committee considers appropriate;
 4. Existing offences and powers in both New South Wales and Commonwealth legislation;
 5. Any other related matters.

That the Committee prepares an interim report on the constitutional aspects of the Crimes and Summary Offences Amendment Bill 2025 by 6 February 2026 and a report on measures to combat right-wing extremism by 23 April 2026.
