Administration of the 2015 NSW Election and Related Matters

The Parliament of NSW's Electoral Matters Committee is conducting an inquiry into the 2015 NSW state election.

As part of the inquiry process, the Committee is seeking submissions from a wide range of stakeholders. The Committee will also hold public hearings in October and November 2015.

Mr Jai Rowell MP, Chair of the Electoral Matters Committee, noted that the inquiry is an important avenue for all NSW residents and relevant stakeholders to "let Parliament know what they think about the way in which the 2015 NSW state election was conducted."

The Committee welcomes submissions from all NSW residents about any aspect of the 2015 NSW state election including the work of the NSW Electoral Commission, ways of voting such as iVote and the rules for election campaign materials.
