Question 1

The Hon. DANIEL MOOKHEY: There have been 13 since 2007 at the level of an improvement notice?

Answer

 Where legal proceedings relating to the Chain of Responsibility (CoR) are undertaken (defined as an Improvement Notice or Prosecution) these often involve multiple parties in the CoR. From an analysis of the legal proceedings, approximately 5% involve consignors. In 2017 one consignor was the subject of an improvement notice.

Question 2

Question:

The Hon. DANIEL MOOKHEY: Before you started your investigation more than half of the truck and dog operations that are a part of WestConnex were not roadworthy?

Ms BAILEY: No, no. Let me say that obviously the breaches are from minor to major and major grounded. Again, I have not got the statistics in front of me about the number of major grounded, but I can provide those. Major and major grounded are the ones I use for serious safety concern.

Answer

 Seven phases of Operation Catapult, a joint RMS, EPA and NSW Police operation targeting truck and dog operators contracted to WestConnex. Roadworthiness results, relating to defect notices issued are detailed below:
