Question 1

Mr RYAN PARK: To date how much has the Government spent on FMT?

Mr GALES: I will take that on notice.

Answer

A total of \$86.7 million has been spent by Treasury on the FMT project as at 30 June 2018.

Question 2

Mr RYAN PARK: This question is probably best addressed to NSW Treasury. Has the State's outcomes framework been approved yet?

Mr GALES: Can I take that on notice? Sorry to answer the same again.

Answer

The State's Outcomes framework (including the 46 State Outcomes and associated outcome indicators) was approved by the Government in March 2018. The 46 State Outcomes and outcome indicators were published in the 2018-19 NSW State Budget, with Budget Paper 3 being framed around outcomes for the first time.
