QUESTION 1

Page 25 of Transcript

In regard to Section 150 hearings:

The Hon. WALT SECORD: How often does that happen?

Dr KENDRICK: I do not have the exact figures but I can ask for them. **The Hon. WALT SECORD:** Is it a handful a year, or two or three?

Dr KENDRICK: Can I just ask?

The CHAIR: I suggest that you may want to table that information at the end of the hearing.

ANSWER

Response: There were 127 section 150s in the past financial year, and there were 18 suspensions.

QUESTION 2

Page 26 of Transcript

The Hon. WALT SECORD: Are the doctors at The Cosmetic Institute, Bondi Junction or Parramatta, in any those categories? Are they being monitored, supervised or out there working away?

Dr KENDRICK: I would need to take on notice specific doctors because I do not have that on hand.

The Hon. WALT SECORD: Dr Eddy Dona?

Dr KENDRICK: No, I mean I do not know the information about a specific doctor right at this moment but I can provide that information, if required.

ANSWER

Response: There are currently no practitioners from The Cosmetic institute who are subject to suspension, conditions or monitoring. The Council has taken urgent action in the past in relation to one TCI doctor, whose conditions were later removed by the NCAT on appeal by the doctor.

Dr Eddy Dona's registration is not subject to conditions.
