

The Hon. COURTNEY HOUSSOS: Obviously, for a State election you have a state-wide cap. While we on this Committee would disagree about the level of the cap, do you think where it has been historically would be enough for a local government campaign? I think it is about a million bucks.

Unions NSW would support a state-wide expenditure cap for local government elections that was consistent with the levels set out in the Election Funding, Expenditure and Disclosure Act 1981 for registered third-party campaigners at state elections. This cap was \$1,050,000 in May 2018.
