Response to Supplementary Questions - Response 1 and 2 Reference Page 34 - Highlighted Response 7

1. Can you advise if the Contact Inc "Who to Contact" information list is still produced, either in hardcopy or digitally, and where can people obtain a copy?

Contact received funding (1979 to 2005) to annually update and produce the “Who to Contact” resource as a hard copy.

This funding is no longer available.

Contact continued to receive requests for the resource up until current times however were not in a financial position to continue publication.

Contact has committed organisational funding however to enable online “Who to Contact” directories to become available on the Contact’s website.

There are three on-line “Who to Contact” directories on Contact’s website – one covering NSW plus two directories specific to the Nyngan and Warren communities that were funded through a one-off Nyngan project grant.

The online directories have been annually updated to ensure accuracy by Contact however limited resources means that this a contained process.

Contact’s “Who to Contact” online directory resource promotion is limited to Facebook/word of mouth and encouraging agencies to promote.

2. If the sheet is currently not produced, are there any plans to resume publishing the list?

In looking to the future, Contact has set up website backhouse functions associated with the web-based “Who to Contact” directories to enable a capability to readily produce hard copy versions of the “Who To Contact” should grant(s) be obtained to enable the future production and distribution of the resource.
