Response: The United Services Union does not have a view on this matter.

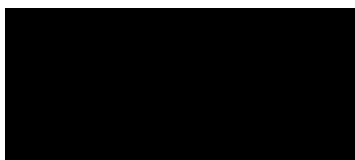
Question: Would you mind asking your membership and coming back to us to see whether we are seeing any such undue behaviour?
