Do you get any complaints about the work of lawyers who have been assigned as children's representatives?

Our Private Lawyer Quality Standards ('PLQS') Unit have advised that from January 2021 until now three complaints have been received about the work of lawyers who have been appointed as independent or direct legal representatives pursuant to Section 99 of the *Children and Young Persons (Care and Protection) Act 1998.* I note that our PLQS unit monitors the quality of legal aid work undertaken by panel law practices.
