Devonshire Road is already well utilised by freight vehicles, and this is forecast to increase. It connects directly to the Mamre Road freight precinct. It is currently one lane in each direction and is planned to increase to two lanes in the future, however my understanding is that this upgrade is low on State and Federal priority lists. This route alleviates freight congestion around the airport by providing an alternative north-south spine to the east of the planned Eastern Ring Road.
