Clarification of information presented at Narrabri Hearing

Thanks to you all for visiting Narrabri on August 14 for the proceedings relating to the above Bill.

On page 20 of the transcript, I refer to the statistics around poorer health outcomes of people living in the Narrabri Shire compared to surrounding council districts. The median age of deaths of both men and women in the Narrabri Shire is earlier for both men and women than in the adjacent shires of Moree Plains Shire & Gunnedah Shire (Rural Health Mapping Tool). I have attached the graph from the Rural Health Mapping Tool, I was referring to in that discussion.


