I have followed up on the Managed Motorway question and the response is as follows:

Current operation in Melbourne of a true Managed Motorway is on the M1 corridor only. Ramp signals extend from Werribee (west) to Berwick (east) and Lane Use Management is over a shorter area in the middle. The M80 upgrade has not yet been brought into true operation from my understanding, although parts of it are certainly in place and functioning to assist during construction. There are also a number of isolated ramp signal sites in Melbourne, but these would not be referred to normally as Managed Motorways.
