

Good morning

Please find attached LPI's response to questions on notice taken before the Public Accounts Committee on Thursday 12 September 2013. I apologise for the delay in response.

- 1) You mentioned in your evidence that 13,000 railway takings are now stored in the register. How many more remain to be entered into the register?

The 13,000 land parcels represents all known railway land identified by Transport NSW. These takings together with the railway lands shown in Deposited Plans represent all the railway land identified to date. There are no remaining identified lands to be entered. LPI does not know what other lands controlled by Transport NSW are yet to be identified but LPI has continually worked with Transport NSW to assist in identifying any remaining parcels and entering them in GPR.

- 2) Can you estimate the percentage of land in NSW that is currently registered on the Government Property Register?

After analysis it has been found that there is no way of determining a percentage that would have any validity or could be used in debate or decision making. The complications of indeterminate boundaries of creeks, of rivers, reserves, some forestry and national park lands, and some crown roads means that simply taking away the area of freehold and government land held in the GPR from the estimated total land area of NSW would be highly misleading.
