General's recommendations.

"The Auditor-General completed his performance audit report on Improving the Performance of

Metropolitan Bus Services in March 2010. This hearing provides an opportunity for the

Committee to hear from the Department of Transport directly. We are looking forward to finding

out more about what the Department is doing to implement the Auditor-General's

recommendations, and its plans for the future of bus services in Sydney," said Mr O'Dea.

The hearing is part of the Committee's follow-up of the Auditor-General's performance audits.
