Inquiry into the Management and Disposal of Waste on Private Lands

The Legislative Assembly Committee on Environment and Regulation will hold a public hearing on Monday, 28 October 2013 to hear further evidence on the management and disposal of waste on private lands, Committee Chair Mr Chris Patterson MP, announced today.

“At its first public hearing the Committee heard evidence from local government and industry stakeholders about the current regulatory and operational framework for managing waste,” Mr Patterson said. “This time we look forward to hearing from the community side of the equation, especially from stakeholders with experience in assisting landowners whose capacity to manage their properties may be diminished by their personal circumstances.”

The Committee will hear from witnesses including the NSW Council for Civil Liberties, Catholic Community Services, the RSPCA, and the Environment Protection Authority.

The hearing will commence at **9:45am** on **Monday, 28 October 2013** in the Macquarie Room at Parliament House, Sydney, and interested members of the public are welcome to attend.
