Statement of purpose

To prevent and reduce the likelihood of deaths of children in NSW.

Aims

1. To identify patterns and trends relating to child deaths in NSW through the analysis of data on the child deaths register

Initiatives

- (a) Establish an integrated NSW Ombudsman death review data system
- (b) Bring the CDRT approach to identifying and reporting Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander status in line with best practice
- (c) Explore opportunities for including injury/morbidity data in CDRT analysis and reporting, and establish processes for obtaining the relevant information
- (d) Undertake cohort reviews of deaths over a 10-year period from specific causes including off-road vehicle fatalities (2013) and asthma (2014)
- (e) Develop information exchange arrangements with substantially similar CDRTs
- 2. To undertake research that aims to help prevent or reduce the likelihood of child deaths

Initiatives

- (a) Develop standard protocols for requesting CDRT data and for assessing such requests
- (b) Explore data linkage opportunities to enhance CDRT work, and to enable research by others that is relevant to prevention

- 3. To make recommendations as to legislation, policies, practices and services for implementation by government and non-government agencies and the community to prevent or reduce the likelihood of child deaths
- 4. To effectively communicate the Team's findings, recommendations, and the extent to which previous recommendations have been implemented in practice

Initiatives

- (a) Identify key agencies undertaking injury prevention or child safety activities and explore opportunities for collaboration or where we can add value
- (b) Develop a media strategy for communicating the key prevention messages
- (c) Identify key issues from annual analysis and reporting of child deaths that warrant broader communication (and identify the best method for doing so, such as issues papers)
- (d) Explore alternative reporting methods, such as geographic reporting and web-based interactive reporting
- (e) Examine ways in which child deaths functions can be integrated (such as reporting)
- (f) Develop methods for evaluating the outcomes/ impact of CDRT work and recommendations on changing behaviour.
