I refer to your letter, dated 8 April 2013, requesting a NSW Police Force response to the Auditor-General's Report on *Responding to domestic and family violence*.

The recommendations in the Audit Office Report relate to a review by Women NSW and Family and Community Services of the 2010 NSW Domestic & Family Violence Action Plan. The review of the Action Plan forms part of the Government's reform agenda for Domestic Violence. The Audit Office Report recommends strategies to be included in the development of a new domestic and family violence whole-ofgovernment framework.

Women NSW is the lead agency for the domestic violence reform process and has assumed responsibility for the collation and coordination of the Government's response.
