In response
to your call for submissions into
sustainable management of natural
resources in NSW we would like to
offer a few of our thoughts to you.

We own 1,400 acres of grazing
land in the North east of NSW where
we run beef cattle. Because we
are in a fairly high rainfall area
our biggest problem is controlling
introduced weeds, we have worked
out a very successful method of
controlling weeds which is cost effective
& sustainable. We do not need
government policy which inhibits
us from sensible maintenance of our
land. We have taken advantage
of a state government plan which
allowed us to lock up part of our
property for the protection of Native Veg

we need more of this type of compensation.

We believe whole of property planning where we enter into an agreement with government which allows us to have security of management for the long term with minimal government interference is the way to go.

The best land managers are profitable farmers. The government should be doing everything in their power to make sure farmers are profitable. The farmers terms of trade are reducing all the time we must put a stop to this

To get the best results we must work together on these important issues not have unworkable policy forced on us

It can be done.
