Dear Chairperson

I am writing to make my submission for establishing a daily inter-regional transport system between Jindabyne and Cooma NSW which would connect with the existing Countrylink operating between Cooma and Canberra. This would open up Canberra and onward to the residents of Jindabyne and its locality.

Currently there is a Greyhound Coach Service operating for 15 weeks of the year which may or may not connect with Countrylink. Cooma coaches do not operate in peak times eg school holidays.

Neither of these seasonal options provide comparable fare structures or pensioner and social welfare recipients fares.

Hence I reiterate the need in this region for establishing a daily inter-regional transport service between Jindabyne and Cooma that connects with Countrylink Cooma and Canberra.
