I am a Tago, old Pensioner living by myself in Jundabyne. Two months ago I visited my Jundaby to ctor about a severe leg pain. The doctor suspected D.V.T. (Daplein Thrombosis) so an ultrasound check needed to be done could Cooma hospital do it. Community transport was not available so an ambulance took me to Canberra hospital. Tests found a large blood clot (DU.T.) from left tighe to ankle. Further tests found large plumorary embolisms (blood elote in both longs plue atvial fibrillation of the heart.)

After a week of medication and treatment discharge was a day to day Proposition without anything definite, Finally about 10.30 an doctors advised I could neturn home to lindaby we and be treated by my own doctor, but

would need to come back for follow ups.

My endeavoors to contact Monara community transport were unsuccessful and due to the short notice it probably couldn't help any how. A social worker advised there was a Country hinh coach actually Picking up at the hospital at 4 pm going to Cooma, I rang County link who faxed a ticket to the hospital. I commend Coonlyhick for having Pick up at the hospital plus faxing ticket to hospital.

Unfortunately at Cooma the coach soutinues on to the South Coast but not lindobyne. So at 6.20pm on a cold late astuma evening I was stranded. I had not been able to contact anybody I know in Sindabyo.
