I believe the trip is too long and could be made shorter.

At present we pick up in Eugowra then detour to Canowindra then to Cudal. It would be better if we could pick up in Eugowra then straight to Cudal, as some of the people who catch the coach are only going to Orange for treatment for cancer etc and some are not well. Maybe a coach from Coura could pick up in Canowindra.

I sometimes come home by the x.p.t. to Orange and change to a coach to Parkes or Forbes, as it goes to both towns.

The service I particularly like is the trip home on a Monday on the "Explorer" that goes out to Broken Hill.

It is a direct trip. I leave Parramatta at 6.45 a.m. and get off at Parkes at 1.p.m. It only runs once a week which is a shame.
