Outsourcing Community Service Delivery

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I wish to state that the privatition of the public sector of Disability and community Servvices should NOT go a head on the following grounds also I have worked across private and government organisations as a support worker.

- 1. The gov organitation provides a greater safety net for clients in the form of managers working hands on in the houses.
- 2. Ratio of works needed for support is balanced in gov v's nongov which are over looked in non gov due to the intense pressure of obtaining funding and this puts clients at risk.
- 3. more experience workers are obtained in gov v's higher turn over in nongov and less qualifed wokrers, therefore more consistancy with staff support for clients and rappal building is more effective in gov v's non gov.
- 4. Monitoring of services gov abides by more check list and thurer contingents then nongov until they are found breaching pracitices, until then a lot goes under the radar which would be picked up quicker in the gov sector as more eyes are watching for the clients rights and sticking to standards and legistative messures, where nongov is more tight budget driven and profit based then the gov organisations who are on budgets but more client focused.

This would be a huge mistake and injustice for clients who after many decades are finally living the good life to there wants and needs under the new life style planning and that the goverment is just starting to get the formular right along with the work that goes on behind the sense in the care of clients this would be a huge disruption clients and there families on the security that a government organitation gives when there is no one eles to turn too or monitor injustice or abuse of most vunrulable people in the community, leaving them exposed to coruption of funding being use for other perposes then ment for just to keep a nongov service runing, key people in the clients life felling abandend with the security of a saftey net when things do go wrong.

I have seen 1st hand staff in government organisations more skilled and client focused where in the non government organisations staff less skilled and greater responsability and wage driven.

I strongly believe society needs the security of both government and private organsiations to service the most vunrable people in the community and giving the choice of service that best suits the clients need.
